NOTICE OF REMOVAL OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS, CIGARETTE PAPERS, OR CIGARETTE TUBES**

1. SERIAL NO. (Begin with "1" Jan. 1 of each yr.)

- The manufacturer or export warehouse proprietor shall prepare the number of copies of Part I of this form required by regulations in 27 CFR Part 290, for each removal from the factory or warehouse of tobacco products *cigars, cigarettes, chewing tobacco, snuff, pipe and roll-your-own tobacco cigarette papers, cigarette tubes*, without payment of tax, for export. On the day of removal of the articles, the manufacturer or proprietor shall immediately forward one copy of the form to the ATF National Revenue Center, Room 8002, 550 Main St., Cincinnati, OH 45202-3263, and the remaining copies shall be distributed according to regulations.
- After the proper certificates (*Parts II, III, IV, V, or VI*) have been completed on the appropriate copies, they shall also be distributed according to regulations.
- Shipments to a CBW may only be entered into a class 9 warehouse and the signature of the proprietor or a U.S. Customs Officer is required in block 52.
