ERROR ON FORM 1582 (REV. 2-69)

Proprietors of distilled spirits plants, wholesale
liquor dealers, and others concerned:

The purpose of this industry circular is to request your cooperation in overcoming a deficiency in the instructions on Form 1582 (Rev. 2-69), Drawback on Distilled Spirits Exported.

Instruction 2(a) on Form 1582 requires the exporter to complete only items 1, 2, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 9. If these instructions are followed, Part I of the form will not identify the bottler or the bottler's assistant regional commissioner.

In order that delays in processing the form may be avoided, it is requested that exporters complete items 3 and 4 in Part I of Form 1582 in addition to the items specified in Instruction 2(a). The form will be appropriately revised when next reprinted.
