Establishment of 11 New Viticultural Areas Within the Paso Robles Viticultural Area

On October 9, 2014, TTB published a final rule, [T.D. TTB-125](#), in the Federal Register establishing 11 new American viticultural areas within the existing Paso Robles viticultural area in San Luis Obispo County, California. The 11 new viticultural areas are: Adelaida District, Creston District, El Pomar District, Paso Robles Estrella District, Paso Robles Geneseo District, Paso Robles Highlands District, Paso Robles Willow Creek District, San Juan Creek, San Miguel District, Santa Margarita Ranch, and Templeton Gap District.

This final rule is effective on November 10, 2014. TTB issued this regulation in response to petitions from a group of local vintners and grape growers.
