CHARGE VIOLATIONS: The proponent violated (1) Title 27, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 24.308(a)&(b) for failure to maintain proper records regarding 36,258 gallons of wine originally reported as breakage; and (2) 27 CFR 24.266(c) for failure to properly report taxable bonded wine inventory shortages that were written off as cycle count adjustments on its monthly reports and failure to report the federal excise tax liability affiliated with those shortages. TTB also found nine other compliance violations under Title 27, CFR, Part 24. BUSINESS IN WHICH ENGAGED: The proponent is a duly qualified bonded wine cellar. DATE OR PERIOD AND LOCATION OF VIOLATIONS: During the period of September 2003 through September 2005, at the proponent's premises located at 3 Stauffer Park, Warehouse #5, Taylor, PA 18517. AMOUNT AND TERMS OF OFFER: The proponent has submitted an offer of \$30,000.00 in compromise of the above violations incurred under the Internal Revenue Code. RECOMMENDATIONS: The Director, National Revenue Center recommends acceptance of the offer. In view of doubt as to liability, acceptance of this Offer in Compromise, as submitted, is warranted.
