The government further alleged that Southern Wine and Spirits of Illinois, Inc., paid or crédited the above-referenced entities for advertising, display or distribution service and/or purchased or rented display, shelf, storage or warehouse space. The government alleged that these acts violated 27 U.S.C. §§ 205(b)(2) (b)(3) and/or (b)(4) and 27 C.F.R. §§ 6.31, 6.35, 6.41, 6.51, 6.56. The government alleged that through these same acts, Southern Wine and Spirits of Illinois, Inc., violated the conditions of its basic permit as set forth in 27 U.S.C. § 204(d).
