DATE OR PERIOD AND LOCATION OF ALLEGED VIOLATIONS: Between April 16, 2009 and September 30, 2011, at 2861 Congressman Lane, Suite 300; Dallas, Texas 75220. AMOUNT AND TERMS OF OFFER: The proponent has submitted an offer in the amount of \$311,881.87. This offer is comprised of a \$180,000.00 payment (paid in equal installments during the course of 12 months) and the forgoing of \$131,881.87 in deductions the company would have been entitled to. RECOMMENDATIONS: The Director, National Revenue Center recommends acceptance of the offer. In view of potential litigation hazards acceptance of this Offer in Compromise, as submitted, is warranted. 9.
