1.	You may file a single application for both specially denatured spirits (SDS) and/or tax-free (TF) spirits (<i>Item 1</i>). The Alcohol and Tobacco Tax and Trade Bureau (TTB) will issue one permit authorizing withdrawal and use of both kinds of spirits.		 Use of spirits free of tax: Your department or agency must use the nonbeverage TF spirits or SDS procured by this permit only for governmental purposes. The department or agency is responsible for procuring and properly using SDS and/or TF spirits under this permit. Officials responsible for the procurement and use of such spirits must take measures to adequately account for all spirits. Discontinuance and Disposition of Spirits: When you discontinue using SDS and/or TF spirits you may dispose of any excess spirits to another government agency holding a valid TTB permit, or in any manner prescribed by TTB. TF spirits or SDS may not be disposed of to the general public. When an agency discontinues using spirits, the permit must be returned to Office of Permitting and Taxation, Alcohol 		
2.	Combined Application: If you choose to have a single permit authorizing all agencies under your control to procure SDS and/or TF spirits, you must attach a list of the agencies with the

Applicant Signature: If someone other than the head of the department or agency signs the application, you must furnish with the application evidence of their authority to sign for the department or agency, if it is not already on file with TTB (<i>Item 5</i>).				
4.	Using Permit: When your application is approved, an original permit is returned to you. When placing an initial order with a supplier, forward a photocopy of your permit with the order.
