
The following enhancements in functionality and interface are included in Version 3.7 of the Permits Online system:

• **TTB Usage Warning Addition** – You may now view the following TTB usage warning in the Permits Online Login and Registration pages:



There is no longer a business need to collect this information. Applications submitted prior to Permits Online 3.7 will still include historical location information.
- Updated Email Notification Content for Approved Amendments You will receive an email notification with the following content when an amendment to your application is approved:

Your amendment to Application tracking number YYYY-CCC-XXXXX-O has been approved. All supporting documents are available from within the Permits Online system and you are responsible to save and/or print copies of these documents for your files. To print/view documents:

- 1) Log into Permits Online and click Search Your Application.
- 2) Click the tracking number of the original application.
- 3) Click the arrow next to Supporting Documents and Attachments.
- 4) Click on the file link to view, print and/or save the document.
