Dear U.S. TTB:

On behalf of the Asian Business Coalition (www.WTOBO.com), WTOBO and allied organizations interested in promoting the interests of the businesses and consumers we serve, we support voluntary nutritional labeling of beer, wines, and distilled spirits.

Overwhelmingly, consumers believe, and we agree, that alcohol companies should be allowed to put this type of information on their labels. Consumers would benefit if they were provided with basic nutritional information on the alcoholic beverages they consume, helping them make more informed decisions about alcohol consumption.

However, under current regulations, alcoholic beverages are largely forbidden from disclosing basic consumer information on labels such as serving size, alcohol per serving, as well as calories and fat per serving.

We believe it is in the best interest of our businesses and the consumers to allow the voluntary labeling of wines, distilled spirits, and malt beverages. Your support for our community consumers on this matter is highly appreciative.
